Would you like to be involved with our community garden? The raised beds, located north of the Community

League Hall and playground and along the multi-use path, are available to rent each summer so you can grow your own food and flowers. Each gardener tends to their own plot and helps maintain the wider Community Garden site by participat-



ing in volunteer teams that care for the garden pathways, communal herb and raspberry beds, fruit trees, turn the compost, or fill the water cisterns. Each garden bed is 4 feet x 10 feet and costs \$30 for the May to October season. Soil and water will be provided - you just bring your own seeds and enthusiasm!

Helping Seniors Age in Place through

Homeshare Canada HomeShare is an intergenerational housing program that addresses social isolation by bringing together seniors and students. In exchange for reduced rent in a senior's home, the student provides up to seven hours of companionship and/or assistance with completing light household tasks, such as preparing and sharing meals, tidying up, carrying groceries, or walking a pet.

Canada Homeshare has funding for a pilot program in Alberta and is working on building a network of "HomeShare" communities across the country that will be connected to researchers, health and community services, policymakers and clinicians, creating opportunities for knowledge exchange, data sharing, and the pooling of resources.
